

Much current interest in genre. Some views attack biblical authority ("myth," "legend"). Missing genre undermines the Bible. Parables. Revelation as apocalyptic. Song of Solomon as love poetry.

-1. An Example: Isaiah

Prophecy. No strong chronological interest. Figurative language. In the framework defined by Num. 12:6-8. Various items within the prophecy: Indictment for present violations of covenant. Prediction. Threat of punishment. Promise of restoration.



Terminology May Vary


"Genre" may cover all sizes.Or distinguish "genre" from "form.""Genre" for the biggest pieces;"form" for smaller pieces.
