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

A. Origin of the Bible

The Bible Is God's Word

All Scripture is <u>breathed out by</u> God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, ... -2 Tim. 3:16

The Bible Is God's Word (2)

For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. --2 Peter 1:21

The Bible Is God's Word (3)

Brothers, the Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand by the mouuth of David concerning Judas, -- Acts 1:16

The Bible Is God's Word (4)

Have you not read that he who created them from the beginning made them male and female, and said, "Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh"? -- Matt. 19:5

The Bible Is Trustworthy

The Bible Is Trustworthy (2)

For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished.

--Matthew 5:18

Do you think that I cannot appeal to my Father, and he will at once send me more than twelve legions of angels? But how then should the Scriptures be fulfilled, that it <u>must</u> be so? --Matthew 26:53-54

Jesus' Testimony

Scripture cannot be broken. -- John 10:35

Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. -- Matthew 5:17

Implication of Jesus' Testimony

seeing Jesus' life the resurrection trusting the Bible trusting in Jesus

Prophecy

He was despised and rejected by men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; -- Isaiah 53:3-4

Remarkable Contents

For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. --Eph. 2:8

Remarkable Contents (2)

For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. -- 1 Cor. 1:18

Persuasion from the Holy Spirit

My speech and my message were not in plausible words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, that your faith might not rest in the wisdom of men but in the power of God. -- 1 Cor. 2:4-5

From the Holy Spirit (2)

The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are <u>spiritually</u> discerned. -- 1 Cor. 2:14

God Gives Meaning


The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.
