Sell based on jubilee 25:14-24
Right of redeeming land 25:25-34
Kindness to the poor 25:35-38
No enslavement of Israel 25:39-55

-What Is "Sabbath"?

Hebrew has a verb "shabat" meaning "cease," especially used to describe resting from labor:

Hebrew: shabat

"And God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it he **rested** from all the work of creating that he had done" (Gen. 2:3).

A pattern





Sabbath Is Rest from Labor

Shabat = "to rest"



"Sabbath" = time of rest

So that's the meaning!





Implications of "Sabbath"

"Sabbath" is a time of resting from labor.

It imitates God's rest.

It occurs in a pattern of 1 in 7.

The sabbath is holy, dedicated to God's glory.

The "sabbath" times can occur in a number of forms.



Weekly sabbath (Exod. 20:8-11)

The day of atonement (Lev. 16:31)

The seventh month as month celebrating rest (Lev. 23:23)

The "sabbath" year: a <u>year</u> of resting from labor

maximal blessing in the future



C. Meaning of Jubilee



When Is the Jubilee?

Count 7 X 7 or 49 years (25:8) "the fiftieth year" is for liberty (25:10) 50th year includes rest for land (25:11)

But the 49th year would be a sabbath year. So do we have two sabbaths in a row?



How Do Israelites Count?

"On the third day he will be raised to life!" (Matt. 20:19)

Friday crucifixion

Saturday grave

Sunday resurrection



Begin your count on the patterned day (not on the <u>next</u> day after it).



50th Is Sabbath of Sabbaths



Next jubilee is 50th year, counting from jubilee = 1

Meaning of Jubilee

The Year of Jubilee is a "giant-sized" sabbath year. It includes rest from toil major relief from debt, loss major relief from slavery and bondage It imitates the Exodus, Lev. 25:42 It is based on God's blessing, Lev. 25:43

Lev. 25:55

God's Reasons

"Even if he is not redeemed in any of these ways, he and his children are to be released in the Year of Jubilee, for the Israelites belong to me as servants. They are my servants, whom I brought out of Egypt. I am the LORD your God" (Leviticus 25:54-55).

10 jubilees lead to consummation (Dan. 9)



Final Jubilee in Daniel 9:24-27

"Seventy 'sevens' are decreed for your people and your holy city to finish transgression, to put an end to sin, to atone for wickedness, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the most holy" (Daniel 9:24).

10 jubilees lead to consummation
