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

Clean and Unclean Animals in Leviticus 11:1-25

The topic of edible animals (1-2)
Land: chew cud and divide hoof (3-8)
Sea: with fins and scales (9-12)
Air: --nonviolent birds (13-19)
--insects with hopping legs (20-25)
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Clean and Unclean Animals in Leviticus 11:24-47

Carcasses:
Insects (24-25)
Land: chew cud and divide hoof (26-28)
Crawlers (29-38)
No animals already dead (39-40)
No creepy crawlers (41-43)
Basis: the Lord (44-45)

Critical Discrimination

But this is about choosing <u>foods</u>.

But it doesn't make sense!

You will find that the principles apply to the whole world.

There are clues to principles.



Beware of Death

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No touching dead from land (8)
Detest the dead from sea (11)
Unclean birds mess with death (13-19)
Dead insect makes unclean (20-26)
Dead from land makes unclean (31)
Carcass makes other items unclean (32-35)
Dead <u>clean</u> thing makes unclean (39-40)

Other Features of Uncleanness

Death makes unclean Death in Gen. (severely). See Num. 3:19, 3-4 19

Focus in 11:41-45 on the ground.

Curse on ground, Gen. 3:17-19

Hint: 11:42, "belly"

"Belly" travel, Gen. 3:14



B. General Principles on Unclean

A General Principle: Order

death, curse, belly travel

point to the <u>disorder</u> of rebelling against God

generalize, symbolize


"Disorderly" animals signify rebellion; "orderly" animals signify faithfulness

God's Character

God is a God of law, beauty, order, and balance.

Opposition to God brings disorder.




Order, Physical and Moral

Oh, so it reinforces what God is saying morally.

God created the physical order of the universe and moral order. He gave Israelites a picture of his order.





Symbolism of Food in Lev. 11

Old world character

Keep from death (13-19) Death

Keep from dust (41-42) Earthly

Keep from belly (42) Evil

Keep from disorder (10) Disorderly, mixed, confused

What about Water Creatures?

So why do fish have to have scales and fins?



Kinds of Order and Disorder

Four feet normal for land.

Fins and scales normal in water.

Two wings and two feet normal for air.

A worm is "gross" because it uses "belly travel."


Why Cud and Hoof?

Chew Cud and Divide Hoof

Divide hoof: divide up the ground

Chew cud: divide up your food, which has come from the ground

Discriminate between good and evil in the world

Discriminate finely before taking it in (making it part of yourself and your practice)

Follow God's order (purification by the Holy Spirit)

Pure in Christ

Creation and Re-Creation

God separates spaces (Gen. 1:6-8) God separates animals (Gen. 1:20-25) God separates tree of knowledge (2:17) Satan attacks God's separations (3:4) Israel imitates God's separations (Lev. 11) Christ perfectly banishes evil You separate by new life in Christ (Col. 3:1-4)




What about TV?
