Remedy for uncleanness (16)

A. The Main Points about the Day of Atonement

What Is the Day of Atonement? "Atonement is to be made" (16:34). Jews call it "the Day of Atonement," in Hebrew Yom Kippur. When?

The special ceremony takes place "on the tenth day of the seventh month" (16:29).Passover (in April) is in the first month.Yom Kippur falls in Sept.-Oct.

Why Do It?

Why did God have them do all this?

To cleanse from sin.





Clues of Spiritual Significance Atonement = cover over, propitiate for sin Cleansing "from all your sins," 16:30. Cleansing includes even the Most Holy Place, the Tent of Meeting, and the altar, as well as the priests and the community (16:33). They are defiled by "the uncleanness of the Needed Israelites" (16:19).

Basic Significance

The ceremony removes <u>all</u> sins, defilements of <u>all</u> the people, including priests.

But repeated every year, hinting that it is not yet accomplished in reality, but only symbolized.


