A. The Character of the Law


Leviticus 18:1-5

Central

The Heart of God's Law (Lev. 18:1-5)

God speaks The LORD said to Moses, 2 "Speak to" the Israelites and say to them: 'I am the LORD your God. 3 You must not do as God is Lord they do in Egypt, where you used to live, and you must not do as they do in the Nations are land of Canaan, where I am bringing corrupt you. Do not follow their practices. 4 You must obey my laws and be careful to fellow my decrees. I am the LORD your God orders you God. 5 Keep my decrees and laws, for the man who obeys them will live by Life follows them. I am the LORD.

Weight of the Fundamentals



Application to You in Christ

God speaks (1) God is Lord (2)

But our culture says it's O.K. Be tolerant.


But popularity does not determine what is right,

Motives for Sexual Law

Gen. 2:24 includes leaving family. Call to Israel is to leave the "world," the practices of the nations. **Punishments follow for disobedience.** 18:24-30Israel is to be wife to God (Lev. 17:7; Hosea) Model covenant with God in sexual fidelity, Mal. 2:14.

Motives for Our Sexual Fidelity

Leaving one's own Leave the world

Punish sin Wife to God Model covenant Love for a different, complementary other Critique TV views of sex, romance, love, marriage, divorce Chastise sin, Heb. 12 **Bride of Christ, Eph.** 5:22-33; 1 Cor. 6:11-20. The final model is Christ.

Responding to Sexual Sin

Sexual sin, like all sin, boils down to selfishness and idolatry (self as idol).

Sexuality runs deep. So the sinful tangles run deep, and are typically not mainly conscious decisions to rebel.

Homosexuality, incest, and bestiality are profoundly selfish, inward-turning, twisted by fear of mysterious complement.

Christ delivers from bondage to self.



Subtle Sin

So, as long as you keep God's rules, you'll be smugly "good." Sin comes from the heart. God cares about attitudes too.



Most dating and many marriages contain two selfish partners looking out for their own happiness.

C. Neighborly Law

Leviticus 19


Loving a Neighbor (Lev. 19:5-18)

Holiness of God implies purity toward others (19:2-3).

- Justice of God implies justice to others (19:15).
- Love of God implies love to others (Deut. 19:18; Deut. 10:17-19).
- Be able to put yourself in your neighbor's shoes.
