### What Is Creation?


"Creation is the act of God alone by which he brings into existence what had no existence prior to the created world."

(As described in Genesis 1:1-2:1.)



# Creation Takes Place in Time

- Creation involves specific acts in time.
- The act of creating has a beginning and an end.
- Creation is not eternal, not always taking place.





# Creation Is Distinct

Creation is distinct from God, not an emanation that participates in divine being.





- Treated as fact in later Scripture, 1 Cor. 15:22.








# Flagellum Cross Section





## Biblical Response to Dangers
