## The Bible Is Christ-Centered

## The Bible Is Christ-Centered

Luke 24:25 And he said to them, "O foolish ones, and how slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! 26 Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" 27 And beginning with Moses and all the <u>Prophets</u>, he interpreted to them <u>in all the</u> Scriptures the things concerning himself.






## An Example: Sacrifices



## Clowney's Triangle of Typology


