A. Starting Verses


1 Corinthians 12:4-6

The church as <u>divine</u> organization



Ephesians 4:4-6 The Church


There is one <u>body</u> and one <u>Spirit</u>—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call—

one Lord, one faith, one baptism,

one <u>God and Father</u> of all who is over all and through all and in all.

Nature of the Church

The church is <u>one</u> (verse 4)
The unity is fundamentally spiritual
It is formed by <u>doctrine</u> (one faith, verse 5)
It is formed by the triune God


Salvation Worked by God: 1 Peter 1:2

according to the foreknowledge of <u>God the</u> <u>Father</u>, in the sanctification of the <u>Spirit</u>, for obedience to <u>Jesus Christ</u> and for sprinkling with his blood:

Aspects of Salvation

Election (being chosen) by <u>God the Father</u>
Foreknown (Loved) by the Father
Sanctified by the <u>Spirit</u>
Called to obey <u>Jesus Christ</u>
Sprinkled (cleansed, declared righteous) by <u>Jesus Christ</u>






Present Blessing for the Church 2 Corinthians 13:14

And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.


Mission of the Church Matthew 28:19

Mission of the Church Matthew 28:20 Presence of God in the Spirit

teaching them to observe all that <u>I</u> have commanded you. And behold <u>I am with you</u> always, to the end of the age."









"I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word,

that they may all be one, just as <u>you, Father, are in</u> <u>me</u>, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

I in them and you in me that they may become perfectly one so that <u>the world</u> may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.





The Fullness of the Spirit
From the Father to the Son
From the Son to the church ("poured out")

Christ Is Prophet, King, Priest: Hebrews 1:1-2

Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets,

but in these last days he has <u>spoken</u> to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world.

Christ Is Prophet, King, Priest: Hebrews 1:3

He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he <u>upholds the universe</u> by the word of his <u>power</u>. After making <u>purification</u> for sins he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,
