
Creation

Mediator in Creation

He is the image of the invisible God, the first born of <u>all creation</u>. 
Mediator in Re-creation



Redemptive Light

For the God who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. (2 Cor. 4:6)

Redemptive Light in Contrast

And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled only to those who are perishing. In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. (2 Cor. 4:3-4)

Moral Separation

And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their deeds were evil. 
-C. Separation of Waters



Structure of Waters


Waters <u>above</u> the expanse (Gen. 1:7)

Expanse: "firmament," "heaven" (Gen. 1:8)

Waters <u>under</u> the expanse (Gen. 1:7, 9)



Meaning of "Heaven"



"Heaven" – the Sky

"the <u>heavens poured down</u> rain" (Ps. 68:8)
"For as the rain and the snow <u>come down from heaven</u> ..." (Is. 55:20)

... the <u>heavens</u> dropped, yes, the <u>clouds</u> dropped water. (Judges 5:4)

And in a little while the <u>heavens grew black</u> with clouds and wind, and there was a great rain. (1 Kings 18:45)

Waters above the Heavens

- The heavens can refer to the sky that you see.
 - Either blue (clear) or black (night) or
 - Clouds (1 Kings 18:45 black)
- ➤ Waters <u>above</u> come down as rain.
- ➤ God has made the whole structure, as provision for rain.
- "... for he [God] did good by giving you rains from heaven and fruitful seasons, satisfying your hearts with food and gladness. (Acts 14:17)



- Separations of waters are created by the Word
- Separations maintained by the Word
- ➤ Blessings undeserved are given by the Word, as a benefit of redemption

Benefits of Waters

- ➤ We are in between; cannot live in water.
- ➤ Water below will have fish.
- ➤ Water above waters the earth.
- ➤ Watering brings fruitfulness.
 - ▶By the blessing of Christ.
- Christ is the source of the spiritual water of eternal life (John 4:14)





Care for Birds
