



Psalm 147:17-18:



The Word Who Is God






III. Natural Disasters and Evil

But he was speaking about the <u>temple</u> of his body. (John 2:21)




















Physical Proportions

Car travel:



Proportions-- distance : time distance <u>in harmony with</u> time Speed = distance/time = 50 miles/hour speed = distance:time = d:t harmony





Acceleration

Plane travel:




time	1 sec.	2 sec.	3 sec.	4 sec.
speed	20 ft/s	40 ft/s	60 ft/s	80 ft/s

Proportions-- speed : time Harmony-- speed in harmony with time acceleration = speed/time = 20 ft/s/s acceleration = s:t = d:t:t


Maxwell's Equations For Light and Electricity


V. Practicing Love in Science
