

- Accumulated data
- Chance is at the foundation of science
- Chance has key role in Darwinism
- Chance in the origin of the universe

# B. The Specification for Chance

#### What Is Chance?

Something that happens unpredictably without discernible human intention or observable cause.

Merriam-Webster

## Predicting Chance?

Time and chance happen to them all.

– Ecclesiastes 9:11

You can <u>predict</u> that chance occurs all the time in everyone's life.

# C. Why Chance Does Not Explain: Regularities in Chance

## Regularities in Chance

- Weather: summer once a year
- Hurricanes in hurricane season
- Car wrecks
- Casinos take in money
- Coin flips: about half heads

# Regularity of Probability

• Coin flips: about half heads

Predictably, reliably

# Three Kinds of Probability

• Logical (on principle)

- Subjective (personal info)
- Objective (factors in world)

- Chance of heads: 1/2
- Chance of two heads:
- 1/4
- Chance of two heads, given you know one head
- Chance of an earthquake in San Francisco

## Roots of Probability

- Logical
- Subjective
- Objective

- In general principle
- In the person
- In the world

$$E = mc^2$$






# Simultaneous Probability

- Logical
- Subjective
- Objective

- Half heads
- Altered by info
- Altered when test shows biased coin





mathematical probability (logical)

spatial pictures (subjective models)



world behavior (objective)

# D. Why Chance Does Not Explain: God's Control

## God's Rule (weather)

Psalm 147:17-18:

He [God] hurls down his crystals of ice like crumbs; who can stand before his cold?

He sends out <u>his words</u>, and melts them; he makes his wind blow and the waters flow.

## Life of Joseph

- Caravan of Ishmaelites go by (Gen. 37:25)
- Joseph in Pharaoh's prison (Gen. 39:20)
- Pharaoh angry at cupbearer and baker (Gen. 40:1-2)
- They land in the prison (Gen. 40:3)
- They land in Joseph's care (Gen. 40:4)
- The cupbearer forgets (Gen. 40:22)
- The cupbearer remembers (Gen. 40:9-13)

#### Life of Christ

- Death by crucifixion (John 18:32)
- Soldiers cast lots (John 19:24)
- No bone broken (John 19:33)
- Side pierced (John 19:34-37)

## Thorough Control

The <u>lot</u> is cast into the lap, but its every decision is <u>from the LORD</u>.

# E. Why Chance Does Not Explain: Biological Tests

## How likely mathematically?

Doug Axe, 1 in  $10^{64}$  to get a new working protein fold.

A trillion times more difficult than hitting the head of a pin with a random throw of a dart

- from the other side of the Milky Way Galaxy

## How Many Proteins to Start?<sup>1</sup>

- 182 proteins in the simplest bacterium (*Carsonella ruddii*)
- 1,354 proteins in the simplest *free-living* organism (*Pelagibacter ubique*)
- What does it take to get 1,354 proteins from scratch?

# How likely experimentally?

- Try with generations of bacteria (E. coli)
- Try by mutating fruit flies
- Observe malaria parasite (billions in one human body)
- Observe HIV mutating

# How likely philosophically?

- Plants and animals are here
- Therefore, they <u>must</u> have got here by some process, however unlikely
- It presupposes materialistic philosophy in the assumptions

## Purpose in What Appears Random

- "Junk" DNA
- Alleged dysfunctional biological systems (human eye has blood vessels out front)
- Alternate genetic (DNA) codes
  - GUU, GUC, GUA, GUG all code for Valine
  - but may vary in production

### H. Chance as a Substitute God

#### Second Definition of Chance

The assumed impersonal purposeless determiner of unaccountable happenings: LUCK

Merriam-Webster

#### Chance in Darwinism

- "Chance" describes what we cannot explain.
- "Luck" is just a word: "what we cannot explain explains it."

### Quantum Mechanics

- Practical limitation in accuracy?
- Permanently unpredictable?
- By us?
- By God?
- No, by us. Proverbs 16:33.
- Does it make sense to give a man-based pronouncement about what we admit is beyond us?
